ORDINANCE NO. 2021-10

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING CHAPTER 50 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES FOR THE VILLAGE OF UNION GROVE, RELATING TO THE HEALTH DEPARTMENT, AND PROVIDING FOR THE DELETION AND/OR SUBSTITUTION OF REFERENCES TO "HEALTH OFFICER" AS THEY APPEAR IN THE CODE, AND PROVIDING FOR THE AMENDMENT OF SECTIONS 14-159, 42-31(b)(2), AND 66-35(b)(4).

The Village Board of the Village of Union Grove ordains as follows:

- 1. That Chapter 50 of the Municipal Code of the Village of Union Grove relating to the creation and responsibilities of the local Health Department be, and hereby is, repealed.
- 2. That Section 14-159 relating to the requirements for a kennel license to be issued be, and hereby is, amended to read as follows:
 - "Prior to the issuance of a kennel license and periodically thereafter, an officer designated by the village shall inspect the premises upon which the kennel is proposed or is in operation and shall report to the village board any condition upon or pertaining to the premises upon which a kennel is situated that might be detrimental or inhumane to the dogs to be kept or that constitutes a hazard with respect to health and sanitation."
- 3. That references to "health officer" in Sections 18-358(i) and 42-31(a) be, and hereby are, deleted.
- 4. That Section 42-31(b)(2) be, and hereby is, amended to read as follows:
 - "Abatement by village. If the nuisance is not abated within the time provided or if the owner, occupant or person causing the nuisance cannot be found, the appropriate Village official or law enforcement officer shall cause the abatement or removal of such public nuisance."
- 5. That Section 42-31(b)(4) relating to the abatement of public nuisances pursuant to the repealed Chapter 50 be, and hereby is, repealed.
- 6. That Section 66-35(b)(4) relating to the management of mobile home parks be, and hereby is amended to read as follows:
 - "Report to the appropriate Village, County or State official all cases of persons or animals affected or suspected of being affected with any communicable disease."
 - 7. That the effective date for this ordinance is January 1, 2022.

8. That this ordinance shall be published, as provided by law.
