

Ordinance No. 1-2024

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTIONS 2-132(a) AND 2-192 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE VILLAGE OF UNION GROVE, RACINE COUNTY, WISCONSIN, RELATING TO THE VOTING REQUIREMENTS TO APPOINT AND REMOVE THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR AND TO REMOVE THE PUBLIC WORKS DIRECTOR.

The Village Board of the Village of Union Grove, Racine County, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

- 1. That Section 2-132(a) of the Code of Ordinances for the Village of Union Grove be, and hereby is, amended to read as follows:
 - "Sec. 2-132. Qualifications; term of office and removal; performance review.
 - (a) The administrator shall be appointed by a majority vote of the village board on the basis of merit with due regard to training, experience, administrative ability and general fitness for the office. The administrator shall hold office for an indefinite term, subject to removal at any time by a majority vote of all the members of the village board or, for cause by the judge of the Racine County Circuit Court. This section, however, shall not preclude the village board trustees from establishing other employment terms and conditions not inconsistent with this section or this Code."
- 2. That Section 2-192 of the Code of Ordinances for the Village of Union Grove be, and hereby is, amended to read as follows:

"Sec. 2-192. Term.

The director of public works shall hold office for an indefinite term, subject to removal at any time by a majority vote of all the members of the village board, or, for cause by the judge of the Racine County Circuit Court."

3. This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption and publication as required by law.
