



ORDINANCE NO. 2-2025

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 14-29 AND 74-37 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES FOR THE VILLAGE OF UNION GROVE, RELATING TO ANIMALS RUNNING AT LARGE AND DOGS AND CATS BEING PRESENT IN VILLAGE PARKS

The Village Board of the Village of Union Grove ordains as follows:

1. That Section 14-29 of the Municipal Code of the Village of Union Grove be, and hereby is, amended to read as follows:

“Sec. 14-29. Running at large.

(a) It is unlawful for any person owning or possessing any Animal to permit the Animal to run At Large.”

2. That Section 74-37 of the Municipal Code of the Village of Union Grove be, and hereby is, amended to read as follows:

“Sec. 74-37. Dogs and Cats.

(a) Dogs are allowed to be in or upon any park within the Village of Union Grove subject to the exceptions provided in 74-37(b), the provisions of Chapter 14 Article II of the Village Code relating to the care and keeping of dogs, and the following conditions:

- (1) All dogs shall be on a leash at all times;
- (2) All dogs shall be under the immediate physical control of a person at all times.
- (3) All dogs shall be licensed and must have up-to-date rabies vaccination.
- (4) All waste from a dog shall be immediately picked up and disposed of. Bags, scoops, or other appropriate implements for the removal of waste shall be carried by any person bringing a dog into a Village Park.
- (5) Dogs are not permitted to be on any park playground structure.
- (6) Dogs must not dig, chase, or harm wildlife, damage park property, or interfere with other park users.

(b) Exceptions.

- (1) No person shall suffer or permit his/her dog to be in or upon Leider Park at any time.
- (2) Dogs are allowed to be in designated areas of the Dog Park, which is part of Legion Park, while not leashed.

- (c) No Dog shall be allowed in or on a public playground or cemetery within the Village at any time throughout the year
- (d) No Cat shall be allowed in or on a public park, public playground or cemetery within the Village at any time throughout the year.”

3. That this ordinance shall become effective upon adoption and publication as provided by law.
